# **Compliance with Governing Organization By-Laws, Policies, and Directives**

(Aligned with Canada Soccer, Ontario Soccer, and the York Region Soccer Association Requirements)

#### 1. Purpose

#### • Board Structure and Governance Practices:

#### 4. Safe Sport and Participant Welfare

• **Education and awareness** sessions on Safe Sport are delivered regularly to coaches, players, and parents.

Bryst's Safe Sport framework ensures an environment that prioritizes **physical**, **emotional**, **and psychological safety** for all participants.

In compliance with the Canada Soccer Guide to Accessibility and Inclusion, Bryst:

- Promotes inclusive access to programs for participants of all backgrounds and abilities.
- Provides accommodation and support mechanisms for players with financial or accessibility barriers.
- Demonstrates commitment to **diversity, equity, and inclusion (DEI)** in recruitment, program design, and community engagement.

#### 6. Ethical Standards and Conduct

Bryst enforces high ethical standards consistent with **Canada Soccer's Code of Conduct and Ethics**, including:
