

Bryst Website Policy

Aligned with Ontario Soccer & Canada Soccer Standards

1. Purpose

The Bryst Website Policy ensures that all online content, digital interactions, and communications on the Bryst website adhere to the standards set by **Ontario Soccer**, **Canada Soccer**, and applicable privacy and Safe Sport requirements. This policy supports transparency, safety, accuracy, and responsible communication.

2. Guiding Principles

Bryst follows the principles promoted by Canada Soccer's **Safe Sport Roster**, Ontario Soccer's **Code of Conduct**, and all related digital communication guidelines:

- Safety: Prioritize the protection of minors and vulnerable participants.
- **Accuracy:** Ensure all published content is truthful, current, and aligned with organizational standards.
- Privacy: Protect personal information according to provincial and federal privacy laws.
- Respect: Maintain professionalism in all written, visual, and interactive website content.

3. Website Content Standards

3.1 Accuracy & Updates

- All information (programs, schedules, fees, policies) must be verified and updated regularly.
- Outdated content must be removed promptly.

3.2 Branding & Representation

• Bryst must be represented consistently, accurately, and professionally.

 Logos and images must follow Canada Soccer and Ontario Soccer branding and partnership requirements.

3.3 Safe Sport & Participant Protection

- No personal contact information of minors may be published.
- Images of players under 18 require parental/guardian consent.
- Content must align with Safe Sport principles: respectful, inclusive, and non-exploitative.

4. Privacy & Personal Information

Bryst is committed to complying with Canadian privacy legislation, Ontario Soccer's Privacy Policy, and Canada Soccer's data protection standards.

4.1 Collection of Information

The website may collect limited information for:

- Registration
- Newsletter subscriptions
- Contact forms
- Program inquiries

4.2 Use of Information

Personal information will be used only for:

- Club administration
- Program delivery
- Communication with participants and families

4.3 Protection of Information

- Personal data will not be shared with third parties except as required for soccer operations.
- Secure systems and encrypted platforms must be used for data handling.

5. Online Safety & Appropriate Conduct

5.1 Website Interactions

Any interactive features (contact forms, feedback, comments) must follow:

• Respectful communication

• Zero tolerance for harassment, discrimination, or harmful messaging

5.2 Reporting Mechanisms

The website must include:

- A clear pathway to report concerns (e.g., Safe Sport, conduct, privacy)
- Contact information for Bryst administration
- Links to Ontario Soccer and Canada Soccer reporting resources

6. Photography & Media Policy

- Only approved and consent-based photos/videos may be posted.
- Team photos must avoid identifying information unless permission is provided.
- No images may portray unsafe, inappropriate, or unsafe activities.

7. Accessibility Standards

Bryst aims to meet or exceed AODA (Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act) website accessibility standards:

- Clear navigation
- Alternative text for images
- Legible fonts and contrast
- Mobile-responsive design

8. Links to External Organizations

Links to Ontario Soccer, Canada Soccer, and related partners must:

- Be accurate and up to date
- Reflect only approved partnerships or sanctioned information
- Not imply endorsement where none exists

9. Use of Club Content by Others

 No external party may copy, distribute, or alter Bryst website content without written consent. • Bryst maintains ownership of all images, graphics, and text created by the club.

10. Compliance & Enforcement

Failure to follow the Website Policy may result in:

- Removal of inappropriate content
- Restriction of website access for contributors
- Escalation to Ontario Soccer if necessary

11. Review & Updates

This policy will be reviewed annually and updated to remain consistent with:

- Ontario Soccer digital and Safe Sport policies
- Canada Soccer governance and communication standards
- Privacy and accessibility legislation
